

Car Parking information for exam candidates

There is NO car parking for exam candidates at Kings Court and parking MUST BE found off-site.

This includes drop off or pick up.

Whilst Kings Court does have a small car park, we are **bound by Horsham District Council legislation** to ensure that **no** LwC visitor car parking is allowed on site.

Below is a list of alternative parking options along with a map to illustrate where they are located with reference to Kings Court

Closer parking options

Lidl and Foundry Lane – 2 minutes across the road and free for 90 minutes with a purchase. You will need to run your receipt through their parking machines that can be found inside the shop.


Stirling Way – a 5 minute walk away. There are a couple of multiple parking bays here that are free from 10am. Prior to 10am, they are permit only. Directions [here](#).

Pollards Drive – a 5 minute walk away. There are multiple residential roads off Pollards Drive that offer free parking with no restrictions (Woodgates Close, Lanark Close, Corunna Drive, Patchings)

Horsham Train Station – a 5-7 minutes walk away. Access to the train station is from Station Road


The Pavillions in the Park – a 10 minute walk away. A multiple car park for The Pavillions Leisure Centre. Pay on exit. More info [here](#)

Hurst Café, Horsham Youth Centre – a 10 minute walk away. Pay and display. More info [here](#)
